In response to the recent COVID 19 epidemic, Makana O Ke Akua has developed and deployed the following contingency plan within our facilities to reduce exposure and respond effectively towards the virus. We have been closely monitoring and analyzing the developments and statements from local, national, and government agencies, and we are taking actions to comply with all directives based on following public health authority guidelines.

We are taking proactive steps in hopes to limit exposure to this virus and help protect our clients and community at large. We remain committed to providing our residents with a safe living environment. We will actively monitor the situation and respond accordingly.

AWARENESS

Makana O Ke Akua has:

- 1. Posted COVID-19 signage, "SHARE FACTS ABOUT COVID-19" and "STOP THE SPREAD OF GERMS", which were published by the CDC.
- 2. Posted signage in every home, apartment unit and in the common areas.
- 3. Asked management to actively check for the following symptoms: fever, cough, shortness of breath in any resident.
- 4. Advised clients to inform us of possible exposure to a person with COVID-19.
- 5. Promoted social distancing of six feet when possible.

PREVENTION & CLEANING

Makana O Ke Akua has:

- 1. Purchased Commercial Grade Cleaning concentrate and provided at least one spray bottle for each home and apartment unit.
- 2. Appointed a specific person to disinfect common areas (door knobs, hand railings, washing/drying machines, chairs, tables) at least three times a day.
- 3. Assigned the individual who has the floor cleaning chore to also wipe down anything with a knob or handle (refrigerator, doors, stove, cabinets).
- 4. Required all residents to wash dishes immediately after use.
- 5. Encourage all residents to constantly wash hands.
- 6. Advised residents to clean and disinfect frequently touched surfaces.
- 7. Advised residents to stay away from those who are sick.
- 8. Advised residents to avoid touching eyes, nose, and mouth.

TESTING

Makana O Ke Akua is:

- 1. Asking any resident who has the following symptoms to get tested at Queens Medical or other medical facility: Fever, Cough, Shortness of breath.
- 2. Requiring those who are tested to bring back a discharge paper clearing them of the virus.

QUARANTINE

In the implausible case that one of our residents are infected with the virus, the property at which they reside will go on lockdown and be immediately quarantined. We will report the lockdown to the local authorities and request for help from the proper agencies.

We trust that our efforts will greatly reduce the risk of exposure to COVID-19. We will continue to monitor this epidemic and educate our residents of the virus. Makana O Ke Akua will continue its operations providing clean and sober living for men.
